Past Meeting Notes—July meeting notes were approved.

Tournament Report—Major tournaments are done except match play. There are two to three matches left so the match play tournament should be completed by the fall meeting date.

The Super Senior event had a player using the white tee on day one and gold tee on day two. Handicap adjustment was correctly made for the tee differences. Since Paul was not at the event to explain the tournament rules the board decided to allow the results to stand.

Membership Report—We have 119 members to date.

Treasurers Report—Current checking account balance is \$22,192.

Low gross must come from a team using the white tees.

Horse race will be played from the white tees.

There will be separate pools for the white tees and gold tees in the skins contest.

Must declare the tee a player will play from by 5:00 pm Thursday, registration day.

Paul will get the banner hung on the trees.

The closest to the pin prizes will be the determined by Dave, John D., and Doyle when they get together to decide the raffle prize allocations.

The putting contest will be handled by Brandon and his assistants. The contest will be from 5:00 to 6:30 pm Thursday evening. The top 10 percent of the entries will compete in the finals Saturday morning. Entry fee is \$25 and it covers the contest and buffet dinner. Guests for dinner will pay \$15.

The room for registration is available from 11:45 am to 4:45 pm; registration will need to move to the front of the building after 4:45 pm.

On Friday at 8:30 there will be a mandatory meeting for each team representative, a Plumas Pines member, to discuss required rules, pace of play, picking up, etc.

Plaques have been ordered; may not be able to engrave with winners names. Plaques will be handed out at the awards presentation and collected for engraving later.

Old Business—Roger will draft a response to a letter sent to the board from Larry Walker.

One of our scholarship winners would like to take his courses on line because he is training for the Olympic team (skiing). As long as the student is enrolled in a college and carrying 12 or more units, on line courses are acceptable.

In the match between Larry Walker and Barry Mitchell the card was popped wrong. The board decided the match should be replayed.
