This new policy will be discussed at the next Board meeting.

Tournament Report – Brad Clark has provided the Board a preliminary tournament schedule for its review. Minor changes are needed on tee times and Brad Clark will work with Brandon Bowling to make changes. Brad Clark will update handicaps on Wednesday and that handicap will be used for Thursday's Men's play.

The golf course will be listed for sale in the next couple of weeks, there's been no decision on opening of Longboards at this time, but lots of ideas are being considered. There will be no change in pricing from last year.
