Board Meeting Notes

March 12, 2021

Past Meeting Notes – Meeting notes from February 12, 2021 were approved.

Membership Report – To date, the Men's Club has received 70 applications for 2021 membership.

Treasurer Report – The Men's Club currently has \$5,262.09 in a CD account and \$7,890.65 in its' Checking account.

The 2020 Federal Tax Return has been completed and sent to the IRS.

The Board made changes to its' scholarship criteria for Portola High School (PHS) applicants. The GPA minimum will be 3.0 (not 2.0) and students attending (college or) a vocational school will also be considered. For 2021, the Board agreed to give two (2) \$1000 (each) scholarships. Jim Greenwald will contact PHS with the updated scholarship criteria and inform them of the Men's Club commitment to provide two (2) scholarships (\$1,000 each) to two (2) eligible PHS students in 2021.

Handicap Report – Handicap guidelines will be updated and posted on the Plumas Pines Golf Resort website and in the Men's locker room.

Tournament Report – Brad Clark has added the missing Men's Club past champions to the Plumas Pines Golf Resort website (updating the Men's Club link). The Past Champions trophy boards in the Pro Shop still need name plates made before they can be updated.

Golf Genius and Plumas Pines Golf Resort scorecards will reflect the new hole stroke index allocation beginning in 2021.

Mountain Classic – Nothing new to report.

Head Pro – Seven (7) new golf memberships have been purchased this year.

Hope to acquire a new or used rough mower.

Longboards Restaurant and Bar will not open to the public this year but the venue will be used for selected special events, only.

Arvo Voip will be returning to the Pro Shop May 4th or 5th. As of March 1st, Arvo became a Class "A" Pro and has been named Head Pro at the Springs Golf and Country Club in Palm Desert.

Old/New Business – Jim Kinkade will work with Janet Grijalva to create both a greeting card that can be used to welcome new members and a sympathy card for members we've lost.
