

Plumas Pines Men's Golf Club – 2023 Local Rules

The R&A USGA Rules of Golf govern all play and are supplemented with the following local rules.

1. Out of bounds is defined by the line between the course-side points at ground level of white stakes. There is an inside course out of bounds along the left side of Hole #18, it is identified by white stakes; these stakes do not apply to Hole #12 and are deemed immovable obstructions on the play of Hole #12. Note: The wooden fence posts and chains on Hole #5 and #15 do not identify out of bounds: they are decorative only and are deemed immovable obstructions.
2. Except for the ball that crosses Aspen Circle from the back tee on Hole #8, a ball which crosses a public road that is out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds, even if it comes to rest on another part of the course that is in bounds for other holes.
3. Penalty areas are identified by red or yellow stakes. All penalty areas are to be played as red penalties areas.
4. The area under the cedar tree, near the 15th green (bark, dirt or landscape) shall be played as ground under repair.
5. French drains in the fairways and rough are deemed to be ground under repair.
6. Logs or rails lining cart paths and the associated decorative rock or bark in the cut-out area adjacent to the cart path are deemed to be part of the path.
